

Employment Law for Fire Chiefs - What To Know

KNOWLEDGE OF THE LAW IS PREVENTION OF LAWSUITS

The session will review the top 5 areas of employment lawsuits that Fire Departments face. The standards of and relationships between the laws will be identified and the confusion unraveled to identify the basic components of the laws and how Fire Departments can address and respond to employment issues of employees. Care is given to identify solutions, not just identify problems, to be proactive and not reactive, and to protect the rights of employees.
