- Avoid minute detail unless appropriate




Perry Twp. Fire Dept. Calls for Service



■Fire ■EMS ■Total


Calls for Service


99% Increase ... (1990 to 2008)






Township Limits

Presentation delivery

- Flow
- Don't ramble
- Time is important!
- Subject-matter expert
- Less is more

Focused presentation

- Speak to their level
