Winning innovations should meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Quality. The creation increases quality in the fire and EMS service. Evidence of quality may include department or community ratings and letters of support.
- **Efficiency**. There is evidence that the creation contributes to a more efficient way of doing things. Ratings and perceptions of outside consultants, and pre- and post-comparison of time involved are examples of evidence.
- Cost Effective. There is evidence that the creation adds value to the department while at the same time containing or reducing costs. Cost data will serve as evidence.
- **Replication**. The creation can be replicated at other departments with a minimum of difficulty.
- **Creativity.** The creation should be original or the adaptation creative. The program description or letters from experts are examples of evidence.
- **Timeliness.** The creation should be no more than five years old at the institution, but must have been around long enough to have been tested, so that it meets most of the criteria.
- Other. Other ways that the creation is worthy of this award.
